Elster is the author of the Joe Joe in the City children's book series and as a professional writer has been recognized several times for her outstanding work.

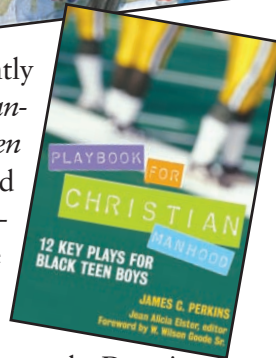
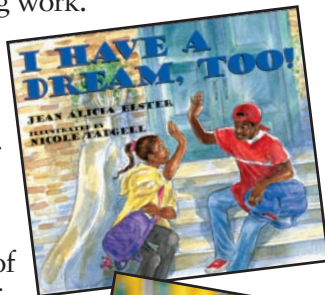
Ms. Elster is available to address the importance of history in literature for youth. Her presentation fee is \$200.00

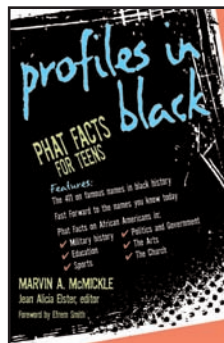

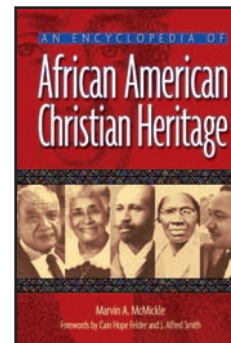

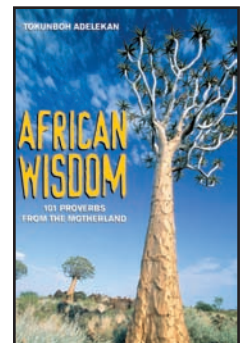
