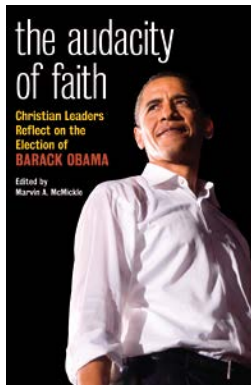


## *The Audacity of Faith* Contributors Will Reflect on Obama's First Term



October 1, 2012, Valley Forge, PA – Shortly after Barack Obama was named the 44<sup>th</sup> President of the United States, Judson Press invited some of the nation's most prominent Christian leaders to share their thoughts on the historic election.
