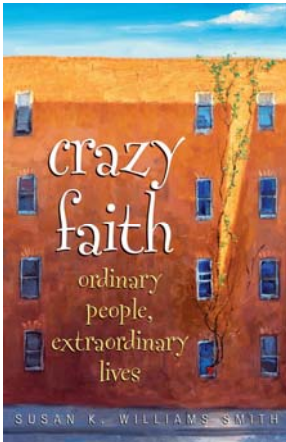


Author's New Book Illustrates the Power of Faith
