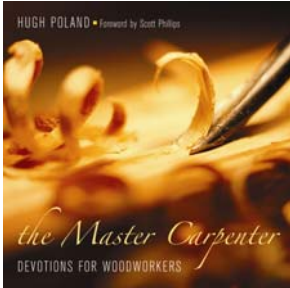


## Inspiration for the Nation's Two Million Amateur Woodworkers
