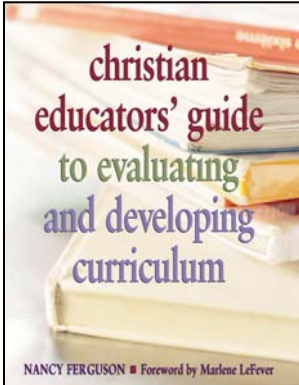


New Resource Eases Frustration for Christian Educators

Within the Christian education department, finding the right curriculum to meet the church's needs is a common source of frustration. In *Christian Educators' Guide to Evaluating and Developing Curriculum*, Nancy Ferguson equips churches to make educated decisions about their resource needs. She guides educators through the process of articulating the goal and purpose of their Christian education program, and then takes them through the process of evaluating purchased curriculum resources, writing curriculum resources, or a combination of the two.
