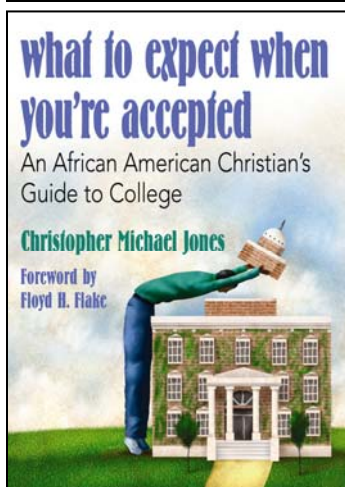


## Collegiate Success Strategies for African American Christians
