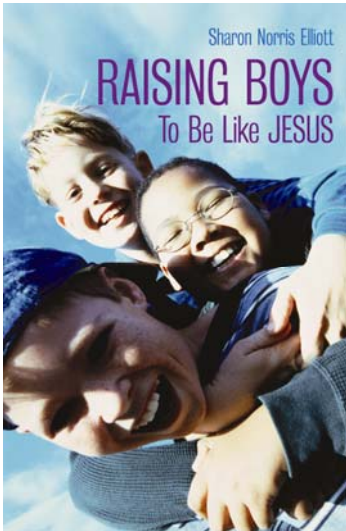


New Parenting Book Offers Jesus as Ultimate Male Role Model
